**Thank you very much for your kind and faithful support to our family! We would like you to know that God has been faithful, that His help has been abundant, and that His care has been sufficient. We also would like you to know that we appreciate each prayer, each gift, each note of encouragement and monthly support. Thank you for your partnership, and thank you for the encouragement to continue to press on.**

**We started this summer with Psalm 100.** In Psalm 100:2a "Serve the Lord with gladness:..." and the end of Psalm 100:5 says "For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and is truth endureth to all generations." We have needed those verses over and over.

**We praise God for his perfect timing, provision, and care during this year here at Red Cliff Bible Camp.** While we had normal winter camps, the summer and fall camps brought many questions about logistics, yet God supplied work groups from all over the country. In September God allowed to have an adjusted, "normal" ladies retreat. **During this whole time, we prayed for health and safety and God answered.** A month ago God brought us to a stop and allowed the virus to reach our town. Even our little town post office was open only 2 hours a day. God little by little helped our whole town. **He has given health, opportunities to share the Gospel, and many creative ways to share the goodness of the Lord to so many.** We are so glad that we can bring our burdens to Calvary; we are thankful that God is so good; we rejoiced that even when we were sick and had to quarantine; His timing was perfect, and that only God can do. We had the fire suppression system crew at camp and that work was able to continue, so even though the camp staff guys could not be there, God knew it was the perfect timing.

**We continue to be under construction, but praise God He is not done with us!** We praise God that the upstairs porch is together, 90% framing is done, 60% rough-in electrical, plumbing is 40% rough-in, heating is 100% rough-in, fire suppression rough-in is started, main floor porch is poured, rock fire place is done, the windows are in (only 8 left to go), and the donated sheet rock is in the building. **We praise God that these many things were done with many churches and families from around the country willing and ready to serve God with their talents.** We praise God that those same hands were the ones God brought for us to minister too!

**We praise God for the opportunities He has given us to minister this year.** We are so thankful for the many that we were able to encourage in God's word and for the many that we were able to share the gospel with this summer, because God opened the door. At camp it was amazing to see the many weary faces come in, and by Tuesday or Wednesday God was all ready changing their countenance and encouraging their hearts. Our own summer staff was a sweet blessing. We saw them grow in phases when God answered each prayer for each week. Here in town this year God has even had people come tell us how much the Bible tract or Gospel booklet has encouraged them. Thank you for praying with us and for us. God is the ONE who is working!

**We thank God for the 141 Bible tracts that went out.** This halloween the stores and town buildings did not give out candy. What a blessing! This was our biggest time yet of giving out Bible tracts from home. God is good! **We praise God for allowing us to give out 100 Bible tracts and booklets this fall.** Right when school started in our town, we wanted to bring hope to businesses around town and the school system. The kids and Wixi would walk in and say "we are just bringing a little HOPE". We only had 3 or 4 people refuse. God truly was the one in control! **God allowed us to paint signs this year with Gospel hope for church members who were home.** Those signs are up in many houses, and we pray that God is using His word.

Not everything was easy, we had our own family struggles. **Anah Grace had 2 different surgeries to remove her knee screws.** She is doing well. We just drove to Jackson for a hand doctor appointment to drained a Ganglion Cyst that develop in the middle of her palm, in her left hand. Because it was causing pain/numbness and it was on her dominant hand, it needed to be taken out (her right hand is smaller and underdeveloped). We are praying that it does not come back so she will not need surgery. Wixi struggled back in March with being concerned about food, since she came from Venezuela. Yet, even on that **God brought a great cook for the summer, who was in charge of our kitchen. She even prepared gluten free meals for Wixi.** Only God could supply even that this year.

**Please pray for safety for this winter season and for God to work in each of the hearts of the campers, speakers, and volunteers. Pray for the summer staff and logistics for 2021.** Only God's hand can give the right help for each of the camps and activities. We are praying for volunteers and helpers with a heart to reach the lost and ready to serve and encourage Christians. Pray for us all that God will work in our hearts, we are trusting Him like it says in Luke 1:37 "For with God nothing shall be impossible."

Would you pray that God will continue to supply for the Loftus, the MacGills, the Holts, and our family? **Have a Blessed Merry Christmas and a Blessed New Year. May God bless each of you and thank you for being a part of our ministry.** May you be encouraged in God's Word: Numbers 6:24-26 "The Lord bless thee, and keep thee: The Lord make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: The Lord lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace."
