His last 32 years he was a shepherd in First Baptist Church of Knox, IN. Many of you had contact with him while we were Missionary Builders since he advised David on his projects and answered supporters for us. He retired almost 6 years ago, and even though he moved from Indiana to North Carolina, he did not stop serving. In the last church he attended, he helped with Sunday School and encouraged many to pray specifically for missionaries.

Dad will be remembered as a man who loved God, a man who loved his wife, a man who loved his family, and a man who loved his church.
